Presentation Design	Clarity, organization, references, impact, intellectual stimulation, interest, and creativity.	 Does my poster look professional? Is it well-organized and easy to follow? Have I used too many words or fonts that are too small? Is my poster aesthetically pleasing? Did I include images, charts, and/or graphics? Are my references properly formatted (in-text citations, reference list, and cited images)? Do my references represent a wide range of quality and trusted information? If it is a group project, is it obvious that everyone contributed?
Learning Connection	The degree to which the project is clearly integrated into the course or advances the course objectives.	 How were the objectives from my syllabus connected to my project? Did I state this clearly on my poster/video? Did I summarize the content learned in a two-to-three-minute video? How did my project relate to my course? What concepts from class discussions or readings apply to the issues addressed by my project?
Impact	Value of the project to discoveries, observations, improvements, and connections to professional or civic goals.	 Why was this project important? How well did I explain my impact? What did I improve, explore, discover, observe, or change? What capacity or benefit did it help build? What past experiences did I connect to ongoing professional and civic goals?
What I Learned (Reflection)	Clearly explain what was learned and how that learning will inform future endeavors. Reflection connects your HIP experience with coursework and transforms experiences into learning.	 Did I include an example or explanation of my/our self-reflections? How will I incorporate the feedback I received through this project? What evidence is there of structured reflection? Did my ethical reasoning strengthen? Am I more competent in a specific skill? What inquiry or analysis technique did I use? Did I gain interpersonal skills or aptitudes? What did I learn from teamwork or problem-solving? How did my involvement in the project foster my sense of civic responsibility?
