- Attain a Mentoring Scholarship at the beginning of the spring semester (\$250 for mentoring one student and \$350 for mentoring two students)

Requirements:

- Be a full-time, thesis-track graduate student in a STEM discipline
- Have a research placement under a UCF faculty member
- Attend L.E.A.R.N.™ Mentor Training on November 3rd, 9AM-3PM
- Mentor one or two L.E.A.R.N. student(s) in your research 3 hours per week, for 12 weeks, during the scholarship period (January through mid-April)
- Mentoring occurs during the same 3 hours if paired with two mentees
- Complete weekly evaluation forms and reflections
