- Removed prerequisite ANT 2511
- Changed SPA 3112C Phonetics with from 4 credits to SPA 3112 to 3 credits with no lab
- Revision of Course Name & Number for SPA 3104 Neural Bases of Communication to SPA 4104 Neurological Bases of Speech, Language, and Hearing
- Removal of LIN 3716L Language Development Lab Course from Core Curriculum
- Addition of SPA 4555 Counseling in Communication Disorders to Core Curriculum
