With over 25 years of experience in Higher Education, Dr. Priest serves as the Associate Vice President, Student Success and Advising within the Division of Student Success and Well-Being. In this role, Dr. Priest provides leadership and vision to the following units: Academic Advocacy, Academic Services for Student-Athletes, the Advisor Training and Development team, First Year Experience, the Knights Major Exploration and Transition Center, the Student Academic Resource Center, and the University Testing Center. She also provides oversight for the coordination of academic advising at the university level through partnerships with the colleges and campus stakeholders.

Prior to this appointment, Dr. Priest served as the Associate Vice President, Student Success within the Division of Student Development and Enrollment Services. Under Dr. Priest's leadership and strong collaboration with campus partners, UCF's retention and four-year graduation rates are at an all-time high, at 93 percent and 55 percent respectively. UCF graduates the third highest number of minorities in the nation, and one in four students is the first in their family to attend college. Dr. Priest's areas of interest include student persistence, academic advising, leadership development, mentoring, continuous quality improvement, program development, and diversity and inclusion.

Under her leadership, UCF has received several national awards. Dr. Priest is a member of the President's Advisory Staff Council, the CSRDE organization's Advisory Board, executive member of the ACE Women's Network of Florida, and liaison and program owner for the Education Advisory Board (EAB) analytics platform. Dr. Priest was honored as one of the top 35 women in higher education by Diverse Issues in Higher Education magazine.
