Theatre BA

- The Theatre BA is designed to offer a thorough foundation in theatre while providing flexibility and opportunity for interdisciplinary study with a required minor. The strength of this program is in the opportunity to combine theatre training with the secondary area of study to create career opportunities in theatre and the entertainment industry.
- Students will choose one of the following specializations:
 - Theatre Studies and Dramaturgy
 - Technical Production
 - Administration and Directing
 - Theatre Education
 - Applied Performance

AI, Big Data, and Human Impacts certificate

- Artificial Intelligence, Big Data, and Human Impacts offers an undergraduate certificate program that examines and engages with human experiences of AI and big data technologies. The program draws from interdisciplinary perspectives across the College of Arts and Humanities in order to provide students with critical and creative approaches to the ethics, uses, histories, and broad implications of big data-driven technologies such as Artificial Intelligence.
