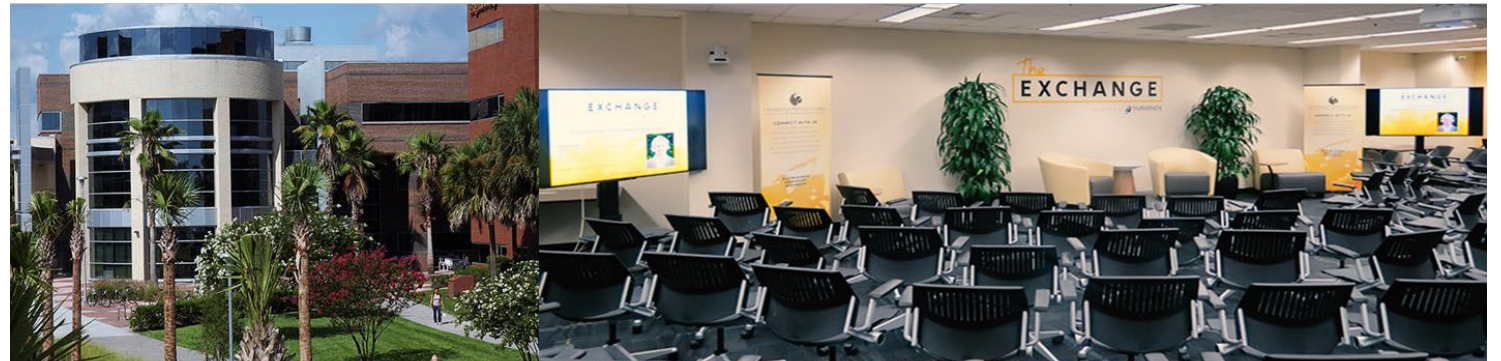

# Office of Professional Development

---

- Office of Professional Development (OPD)
  - UCF undergraduate students considering a College of Business program should be referred to the Office of Professional Development for assistance
  - Students with a declared College of Business major can schedule an appointment through myKnightStar or attend walk-in advising (dates/times posted within OPD Resource Course)
    - Academic Success Coaching (Advising), Student Empowerment, and Career Coach appointments – BA2 101
    - Study Abroad appointments – BA2 203
  - Students interested in a College of Business program can attend walk-in advising on most Wednesdays 8:30am-11:30am and 1:00pm-4:00pm (first come, first served until capacity is reached)
  - OPD services (Coaching/Advising, Empowerment, Career Coach, and Study Abroad) are offered in-person

## College of Business Restricted Access

The College of Business is a **restricted access** college. Students in BSBA programs must meet certain requirements before they are admitted to their major/college.

**To be admitted, students must successfully complete:**

- ✓ **General Education Program\***
- ✓ **Common Program Pre-requisites with a “C” or better**
- ✓ **Business Primary Core\*\***
- ✓ **GEB 3006\*\***

*\*Students who have earned an AA degree from a Florida Public Institution have their General Education Program satisfied*

*\*\*Requirements are major specific; Please contact OPD for additional information*

# Program Updates – Career Professionalism Series

---

- Existing
  - Required for College of Business BSBA Majors
  - GEB 3006 → GEB 3005 → GEB 4223 → GEB 4004
  - GEB 3006 is a part of our Admission Standards for BSBA majors
  - Course content better aligned to prepare students for post-graduation employment
  - All GEB courses have the traditional grading scale (ex. A-F)
  - Only open to College of Business majors
    - This is not a course for students considering a business major, but rather for students who are declared in our college with all course prerequisites met
- New
  - Updates to course prerequisites



# Program Updates

---

- Economics BSBA
  - The required course list has been updated to provide greater availability
  - Starting Fall 2024 ECO 4400 and ECO 4934 has been removed and replaced with two (6cr) U/L business electives
- Management BSBA
  - MAN 4583 (Project Management) will now be restricted to Integrated Business BSBA majors
  - MAN 4580 (Enterprise Project Management) has been created for Management BSBA majors to satisfy this degree requirement
- Accounting Minor
  - Language has been added to the catalog to clarify the course overlap policy for the Accounting Minor
- Finance Minor
  - Language has been added to clarify admission requirements for the Finance Minor

# Transfer Students Tips

---

- College of Business Administration
  - Prospective transfer students interested in our BSBA majors are encouraged to complete the Common Program Prerequisites (CPPs) prior to attending UCF
    - Strong grades in CPPs increase potential for academic success at UCF
  - We are a restricted access college, which means students must meet our Admission Standards to move from the pre-major status
  - Once admitted to UCF, declared business majors (including pre-majors) are not permitted to take business coursework transiently.
  - College of Business courses are offered in-person or in the R.E.A.L. format
    - We do not have an online undergraduate program
