



## **NEW CRIMINAL JUSTICE TRACK**

- Criminal Justice, Professional Track (B.A. or B.S.)
- Students earn their State of Florida Law Enforcement or Corrections Officer certification while completing their bachelor's degree.
  - Students complete the law enforcement or correctional officer academy as part of their required 12 credit hour internship.
- Students are workforce eligible immediately upon graduation.
  - Central Florida Chiefs of Police, Sheriffs, and Department of Corrections have identified a need for 500+ law enforcement and correctional officers in the next 3 years.
- Students will have opportunities to network with potential employers throughout the program.

## HEALTH INFORMATICS AND INFORMATION MANAGEMENT UPDATE

- Moving from Restricted Access to Open Access Fall 2024
- No separate major application required
  - Students should declare major as Health Informatics and Information Management
  - Minimum overall GPA of 2.5 and minimum grade of a "C" (2.0) in prereq's and major courses
  - Prerequisites

    - PCB3703C Human Physiology (4)
    - CGS2100C Computer Fundamentals for Business (3)

## NEW HEALTH INFORMATICS B.S. DEGREE

Starting Spring 2025 pending Final approval (UCF Board of Trustees and SUS Board of Governors)

- Program will focus on the development, maintenance, and appropriate use of health information, preparing students for careers as healthcare data analysts, healthcare IT consultants & project managers, and related roles bridging technology and healthcare delivery.
- Curriculum includes:
  - Fundamentals of health informatics, healthcare data management, electronic health records, healthcare IT systems, information security and privacy, data analytics, and evidence-based practice.
  - The design, implementation, and optimization of information systems used in healthcare settings such as hospitals, clinics, and public health organizations.
  - Data mining, big data analytics, machine learning, and predictive modeling techniques applied to healthcare data.
  - All students will participate in an internship field experience providing real-world exposure to health informatics roles in an organizational setting.
