## Science GPA Graduation Requirements

- Biomedical Sciences – no requirement
- Neuroscience track – 3.0 Science GPA
- Pre-Medical track - 3.0 Science GPA
- Biotechnology – no requirement
- Medical Laboratory Sciences – 2.5 MLS GPA
- Molecular & Cellular Biology- 3.0 Science GPA
- Molecular Microbiology – 3.0 Science GPA
