Program Overview

Soldiers to Scholars Program

- Open to honorably discharged veterans who are enrolled at UCF, Valencia College, Seminole State College
- Agree to volunteer 10 hours per week with at-risk youth
- Provide mentorship and guidance to elementary aged children
- Provides tuition assistance and a book stipend for student veterans who meet requirements

Veteran Success Camp

- Launches Fall 2024 as a 6-hour workshop
- Designed to provide student veterans with tips and tricks to success in a university setting.
- All first-semester student veterans will be required to attend the workshop

Updates & Reminders

Updates

- Military students using Chapter 33 benefits must be enrolled as full-time student (12 hours) throughout the entire semester to receive maximum benefits.
- Certification windows open 30 days prior to semester start date.

Reminders

- Military Students must be enrolled in classes before their hours can be certified for the VA
